Clerk's Report – 17 October 2022

Update on outstanding items:

Refurbishment of street furniture and notice board in Pamington: one quote received for refurbishing the bench and vandalised notice board, awaiting further quotes for both

Manufacturer damage to newly installed notice board in Barleyfields: This has now been replaced and is therefore completed

Parish Noticeboards: Council are mindful of noticeboard refurbishments across the parish and this will be added to the agenda for the next council meeting

Flood sign: GCC Highways have raised job with contractor who will be looking to carry out their signage programme late September/October

New Defibrillator: Clerk has requested quotes from painter and decorators for telephone box refurbishment and is awaiting responses

Clearing of ditches in Pamington: Clerk communicating with residents via letter. Extending to Natton

Pedestrian access along the B4079 between Aston on Carrant and Aston Cross: Overgrown vegetation had been cleared and funds had been made available for improvements from Tewkesbury Borough Council. Awaiting confirmation of meeting date with County Councillor Vernon Smith, the local Highways Manager, Councillors and the public

A46 Traffic: National Highways acknowledged the issue raised and confirmed the traffic light reassessment would commence upon completion of the Alexandra Way roadworks. Has been reassessed however no update has been provided

M5 Improvements: Montel Civil Engineering have commenced a project to widen the M5 junction 9 northbound slip road and roundabout. This has been publicised on the ARPC website and Facebook page

Pamington Dog Bins: Awaiting confirmation of acceptance from UBICO via TBC. To be added to agenda of next parish council meeting
