#### **Update on outstanding items:**

**Refurbishment of street furniture and notice board in Pamington:** two quotes received for refurbishing the bench

**Flood sign:** GCC Highways have raised job with contractor who will be looking to carry out their signage programme in December

**Clearing of ditches in Pamington:** Clerk has sent letters to residents and is arranging letters for Natton residents

**Natton Culvert and Flooding:** Clerk liaising with Environment Agency to request clearing of Tirlle Brook. Clerk continues to investigate the history of work carried out on Natton railway culvert

**Pedestrian access along the B4079 between Aston on Carrant and Aston Cross:** Overgrown vegetation had been cleared and funds had been made available for improvements from Tewkesbury Borough Council.
