Update on outstanding items:

Natton Culvert and Flooding: Clerk liaising with Environment Agency to request clearing of Tirle Brook. Clerk continues to investigate the history of work carried out on Natton railway culvert

Telephone Box and Defibrillator at Fiddington:

Clerk has placed order for defibrillator (expected delivery within 10 weeks) and is continuing to arrange further quotes for telephone box refurbishment. Clerk has successfully applied for a free paint scheme aimed at those repurposing old BT telephone boxes and received voucher from local supporter. Clerk has quotes for replacement parts as requested.
