Clerk's Report – 22 May 2023

Update on outstanding items:

Post box: Clerk has raised a case with Royal Mail requesting the demolished (from a car accident) post box at the junction of Fiddington Lane and Walton Cardiff Lane is reinstalled. Awaiting response.

Taxi vouchers: 2023-2024 allocation of taxi vouchers has been distributed. A new Facebook campaign has been published to encourage new applications.

Community Speedwatch: Training with an enforcement camera officer is being organised for volunteers - date and venue to be confirmed. A new Facebook advert to recruit volunteers has been published.

Dog Bins for Pamington and Barleyfields: New dog bins have been installed at Barleyfields by Linden Homes. Clerk organising dog bins for Pamington as agreed at January APRC meeting.

Parish defibrillators:

The new defibrillator is now installed in the Fiddington Lane telephone box. It is live on the ambulance system for use when needed. The refurbishment of the telephone box is being progressed.

Noticeboard removal: Clerk organising removal of Ashchurch Rural Parish Council branded noticeboard from Camomile Way, Walton Cardiff following parish boundary changes.

Roadworks:

Completed:

• Fiddington Lane - Closed 15th – 17th May for resurfacing

Ongoing:

Claydon, Fiddington - The road above will be closed (as per the attached plan) from 08.00 on 09/05/23 – 17.00 on 11/05/23. This road closure is required by Severn Trent Water to carry out apparatus renewal in this location. Residential, Emergency and Pedestrian access will be maintained.

Grange Road, Northway (Level Crossing) - The road above will be closed (as per the attached plan) x3 separate weekends between 12/05/23 - 25/06/23.

23.00 on 19/05 – 07.00 on 22/05

21.00 on 24/06 - 10.00 on 25/06

This road closure is required by Network Rail to carry out track renewal in this location. Access will not be maintained due to the nature and safety risk of the works involved.

Highways:

Issues raised with Highways last month updates;

- Long grass on the B4079 awaiting confirmation of completion
- Pot holes on B4079 work is being carried out on northern section (towards Bredon). No update on if /when the southern section (towards Oxenton) will be repaired.
- Moog Traffic Lights and traffic tail backs on A46 response received stating this is being monitored weekly and confirming Moog lights are in working order and not to blame for traffic.
