Ashchurch Rural Parish Council (ARPC) uses cookies on its web site. By using the service, you consent to the use of cookies.

This policy explains what cookies are, how to control them and how the ARPC use them.

What are cookies

Cookies are small files placed on your device by your browser when you visit a web site. These files are also read back by the web site. The files may be deleted at the end of your browsing session or they can be persistent cookies that remain on your device and are read when you return to the web site.

Cookies can be used to record such things as your acceptance of this policy for future visits.

How to manage cookies on your devices

Your web browser will have settings to control what cookies, or none, can be placed on your device. The Information Commissionaire's Office web site has information to help with this...

Cookies used by ARPC's web site

- They are used to remember your preferences
- Session cookies are used for the correct functioning of the website
- Google Analytics uses them to keep statistics of what pages have been visited, for how long and other session information may be saved for statistical purposes only.

The ARPC web site does not use any cookies to track you.
