TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH AAS 23
(ASHCHURCH PARISH) TEWKESBURY BOROUGH

NOTICE is hereby given that Gloucestershire County Council intend to make an Order to close temporarily under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 (as amended) part of the Public Footpath AAS/23 from a point on the service road south of the A46 and east of the railway line at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 9270/3323 (Point A on the order plan) and running in a generally southerly direction for approximately 250 metres to a point at OSGR SO 9278/3299 (Point B) at the junction with Footpath AAS/24 by the bridge over the watercourse and shown by a solid black line on the order plan.

The footpath falls within Ashchurch Parish in the Tewkesbury Borough, in the County of Gloucestershire.

The closure is necessary to safeguard the public whilst construction works take place.

The order will come into force on 8th September 2021 and it is anticipated that the footpath will remain closed until 7th February 2022. After this date if the closure is still required it will be necessary to apply to the Secretary of State for an extension of time.
